MASS THEME EXPLAINED

3rd Sunday after Easter

“A little while and you shall see Me no longer, ... because I go to the Father ... And therefore, have sorrow now; but I will see you again, and your heart shall rejoice, and your joy no one shall take from you” (GOSPEL).

Christianity is a religion of joy! (INTROIT). May “those` ... in error” receive this “light” (PRAYER). Jesus predicts, however, that our joy can never be perfect here. The “cross before the crown” (ALLELUIA VERSE) would indeed be a mystery had not Jesus lived it out for us.

An unbelieving “world shall rejoice” because it regards Him as dead and gone. But Christ departs only for a “little while” (GOSPEL) to test our love and loyalty. He shall return (as indicated by little figure of Christ in the clouds).

Prepare for His coming “in the day of visitation” by good example. “Behave yourselves honorably among ... pagans; that ... they ... observing ... your good works” for God and country (described in the EPISTLE) may recognize that Christianity is a religion of joy, now and forever!
