MASS THEME EXPLAINED

4th Sunday after Easter

“If I do not go, the Advocate will not come; ... but if I go, I will send Him to you ... He will (convince) the world ... of justice” (GOSPEL).

The Sunday of Justice of Jesus, interior and social! The Holy Spirit descends upon us with His Seven Gifts at our Confirmation (symbolized by the Dove). He puts before us the imitation of Christ’s sinless example, since “the prince of this world” had tried to confuse and even destroy the correct ideas of right and wrong. Hence, we may now sing “a new canticle,” because God “hath revealed His justice” (INTROIT).

The EPISTLE and OFFERTORY extol the gifts of interior “justice;” the PRAYER; evidently referring to social “justice,” makes us realize that only God can “make (all) of one will.”

How do we react in thought and action to this twofold standard of “justice” revealed in the Life of Christ and taught us by the “Spirit of truth?”
